Day 1

Anterior Course. The lecture will cover the planning, theory and principles behind composite resin technology, specifically aimed at the anterior smile zone. Hints and tips will also be given to ensure simple, easy placement techniques, while doing so within realistic time constraints. Exercises will largely be based around making putty stents and learning the importance of layering to surpass your patients' expectations.

Day 2

Posterior Course. The second day lecture will cover the latest trend to simplify posterior restorations while ensuring complete function for the patient. The techniques shown will be carried out by the delegates in the extensive handson sessions, to ensure these simple tips will be carried into everyday practice. Exercises will include the restoration of a Class I, as well as further exercises on Class II cavities ensuring good contact points are achieved.
